Benefitting Parenting, Pregnancy & Adoption, and Homelessness & Housing



We see many clients every day and so many come in hungry. These snack bags will help our clients access the resources they need without being hungry. We also hand out these snack bags to kids as they wait for their parents to receive services and to encourage clients at the St. Jude Centers to participate in community building activities!

Add a drink and snacks to a small paper sack.
Decorate the sack with encouraging notes and pictures!

Materials

- Paper bags
- Chips
- Crackers
- Juice boxes
- Bottled water
- Pretzels
- Markers (to decorate bags)

Materials Needed:

- Crackers
- Any small sweet treats
- Gallon-Sized Ziploc bags
- Bottled water
- Canned Protein (pull-tab cans)

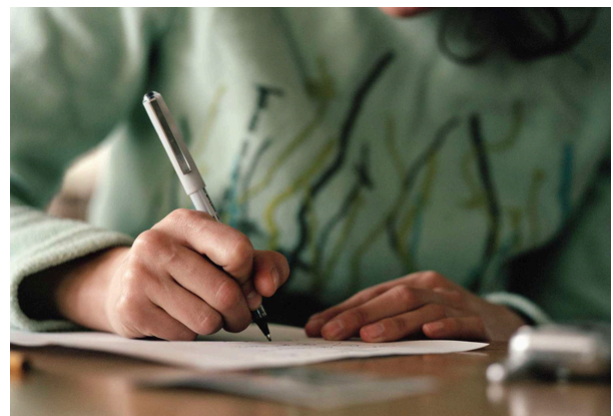
Optional: While notes are most appreciated, many arrivals can also use Walmart gift cards in any amount to buy new essentials items.

Prize Bags

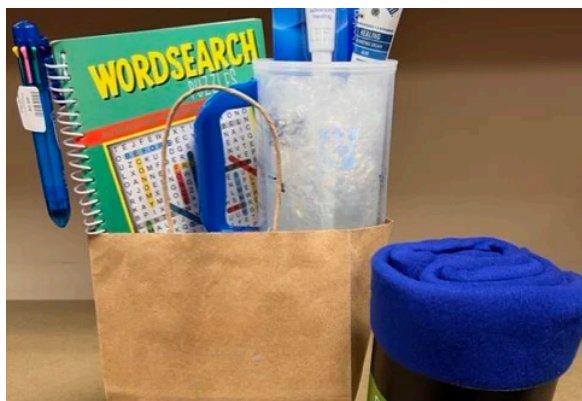
Benefitting the Brady Senior Center
